An exhibition featuring the works of prominent Indonesian graphic art illustrators.


Their works questions the reality, identity, and social structure that they encounter. All through the power of social media platform.


Art at WTC

Art at WTC is a joint initiative from ISA Art & Design and Jakarta Land to showcase and introduce art beyond the art public.

Since 2016, ISA Art & Design has been appointed as the main art consultant for the World Trade Center complex in Jakarta. We set up frequent art exhibitions throughout the year at the lobby of WTC II & III, which showcase the works of prominent and emerging young artists of Indonesia, and throughout the region. Through close diplomatic collaborations with different international embassies we also produce bi-yearly art exhibitions that provide a conventional platform for creative intercultural exchange.

Otherworldly and open to interpretation, the symbols are juxtaposed with floral images and tropical colours. The works **TEMPA** presents prompts multitudes of fantasy in our minds; from a possible spiritual society to an agrarian-punk civilisation.

Tempa is a graphic design studio founded by Rara Kuastra & Putud Utama. Tempa does not limit themselves to design, illustration or artistic services, but also create products with basic needs for design and aesthetics such as fashion, craft, prints, paper goods, textile design, home decor, furniture, and many more.
